• The Mission of Relay For Life of Bermuda is to raise awareness and funds to Support cancer prevention, detection and treatment in the fight against cancer.

WE ARE BRINGING OUR COMMUNITY TOGETHER TO RELAY FOR **18 HOURS** TO:

- Celebrate survivors for what they have overcome
- **Remember** those lost to the disease and those fighting the disease
- Fight Back and inspire participants to take action against a disease that has taken too much
- 97% of funds raised support Bermuda Cancer and Health Centre's Equal Access Fund; ensuring that everyone can utilize the Centre's services (mammography, ultrasound, breast & prostate biopsies and radiation therapy) without a co-pay, regardless of their level of health insurance or ability to pay.
- 3% funds Global Relay For Life's cancer control initiatives worldwide.

Reminder to plan for adequate floats if holding cash based fundraiser





- Barritt's Ginger Bombers sponsored Water Station on site: Bring refillable bottles
