### **CANCER IN BERMUDA**

Each year in Bermuda over 300 of our friends and family are told "You have Cancer" and sadly 80 people will lose their battle to cancer each year. These statistics are too high considering nearly 50% of cancers can be prevented.

#### WHAT IS RELAY FOR LIFE?

Relay For Life is not just an event. It's a life-changing experience. A place where you get to experience the full range of emotions, from utter grief and sorrow to incredible joy and laughter. A place where a survivor will meet another survivor who has had the same cancer and is alive, and HOPE is born! Where a caregiver will meet another caregiver and realize they have travelled the same path and have found peace. Relay is an experience!

The American Cancer Society's Relay For Life © programme is the largest non-profit movement in the world in the fight against cancer. Relay For Life is a 24-hour experience which encourages communities to come together as part of a global movement to end cancer. For three decades, Relay For Life has provided inspiration and hope to millions of cancer survivors and caregivers. Beyond this, Global Relay For Life funds cancer research, education, advocacy, prevention, and treatment.

## **RELAY FOR LIFE OF BERMUDA**

In 2013, Bermuda became the 21<sup>st</sup> country to be licensed by the American Cancer Society to hold a Global Relay For Life event. Today there are over 29 countries holding Relay events.

What Bermuda has to say about event sponsorship:

- 76% of residents say health-related issues were the most valued corporate sponsorships
- Residents were more likely to name Relay For Life as top events, programs or charitable causes in Bermuda
- Sponsoring giveaways (61%) and being a lead or title sponsor of an event (55%) were seen as 'very effective' ways that companies could create a presence for themselves.
- 57% believed that being a small sponsor for many events or a large sponsor of one event were equally as effective for elevating a company's brand awareness.

#### **BERMUDA CANCER AND HEALTH CENTRE**



Bermuda Cancer and Health Centre is a registered Bermuda charity #70, working to serve the community building healthier lives free of cancer and disease. Clinical services include 3-D and Digital Mammography, Ultrasound, Breast and Prostate Biopsy, Bone Densitometry and Radiation Therapy cancer treatment.

The Radiation Therapy Unit has a clinical affiliation with Dana-Farber/Brigham and Women's Cancer Centre and is the first international centre to earn accreditation from the American College of Radiology.

Bermuda Cancer and Health Centre strongly believes that health screenings such as mammograms and ultrasound and treatment like radiation therapy should be available to everyone regardless of insurance coverage or ability to pay.

## In 2022:

- \$1.3 million was donated by our community to support the Centre's programmes and services
- 680 patients received services through the Equal Access Programme (uninsured and underinsured subsidisation) in great part due to the funds raised by Relay For Life:
  - 654 diagnostic imaging patients
  - o 10 radiation therapy patients
- 325 volunteers making what we do possible
